GENERAL ORDER
NUMBER 16

WHEREAS, the Act of December 18, 1971, created the above
entitled District: now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. All full-time clerical employees employed by the
United States Probation Officer and paid by the United States are
hereby appointed in the above entitled District to the same
positions now held by each of them, with the same powers and duties
and at the same respective grades and salaries with credit to be
given in future promotions and step increases in salary for past
services: and
2. Said employees are hereby continued in their respective
offices for the United States District Court, Eastern District of
Louisiana, Baton Rouge Division, for the purpose of performing
such duties as may devolve upon them for the Eastern District
of Louisiana, Baton Rouge Division, as it existed prior to the
effective date of said Act, by statute, by the respective orders
of appointment and any subsequent orders.
3. In the event individual appointments may be required,
such appointments will be effective as of the effective date of
said Act.

This Order shall become effective commencing April 16,
1972.
