
GENERAL ORDER
NUMBER 27

WHEREAS, Rule 26 C of the General Local Rules of this Court provides additional duties that may be performed by the United States Magistrate, and WHEREAS Rule 40(b) (5) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure provides that a United States Magistrate when authorized by local rule of Court may issue a warrant of removal under Rule 40(b) (3), now therefore:

IT IS ORDERED that on and after this date, the United States Magistrate be, and he is hereby authorized to issue warrants of removal under Rule 40(b) (3) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be filed among the General Orders in the Office of the Clerk of this Court, and that it remain in effect from this day onward unless and until rescinded or modified by order of this Court.
