MATTER SHALL BE ALLOTTED TO THE SECTION TO WHICH THE
EARLIER PROCEEDING WAS ASSIGNED, UNLESS THE COURT
DETERMINES THAT SOME OTHER PROCEDURE IS IN THE INTEREST
OF JUSTICE.
