
REVISED PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED
BY UNITED STATES MAGISTRATES IN HABEAS CORPUS MATTERS

Part A1 of General Order 57 is revised as follows:

1. Habeas Corpus Matters shall be automatically referred to the assigned magistrate by the clerk of court. The magistrate shall, within two working days after reference, review the application for proper venue and failure to exhaust state court remedies and shall make appropriate recommendations to the judge.
