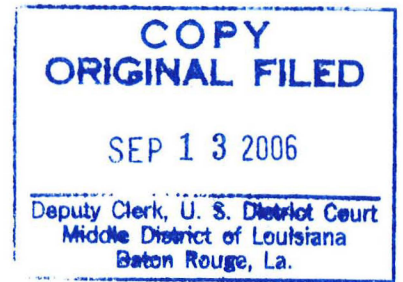


Order for Disclosure of Presentence Report to Treatment Provider




