Paragraph I.B of General Order Number 2005-12 is hereby amended as follows:

In order to ensure the random assignment of cases to the fullest extent possible in a fair and equitable manner, the Clerk of Court shall assign all cases on or after February 21, 2007 in the following manner until further orders of this Court.

B. Assignment of Cases

The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign civil cases in the following percentages:

Section JVP	25%
Section FJP	25%
Section RET	25%
Section JJB	25%

The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign criminal cases in the following percentages:

Section JVP	25%
Section FJP	25%
Section RET	25%
Section JJB	25%

Paragraph II A. of General Order Number 2000-2 is hereby amended as follows:

- A. There shall be a separate section described as a "card deck" established within the system for each of the categories set forth below in assigning cases to each active and senior district judge in the proportions set forth in Paragraph I. B.
1. Civil Cases
 2. Criminal Cases




All Orders or General Orders to the contrary are hereby vacated and set aside. This order shall be effective February 21, 2007.


