ISSUANCE OF WRITS OF HABEAS CORPUS IN CRIMINAL CASES

The court finds that in the interest of Judicial Economy and efficiency, the following procedures shall be followed in issuing of Writs of Habeas Corpus in all Criminal Cases:

- (1) For those prisoners housed within the State of Louisiana, the Writ to produce said prisoner shall be in the possession of the United States Marshal at least five (5) working days prior to any hearing.
- (2) For those prisoners housed outside the State of Louisiana, the Writ to produce said prisoner shall be in the possession of the United States Marshal at least ten (10) working days prior to any hearing.
