Considering the interests of judicial economy and efficiency,


IT IS ORDERED that all appeals from the bankruptcy court shall be assigned directly to the United States District Judge to whom any prior appeal in the same or a related bankruptcy case was assigned.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that motions to withdraw the reference of cases and proceedings to the bankruptcy court shall be assigned directly to the United States District Judge to whom any prior appeal, or any prior related civil action filed in or removed to the United State District Court and referred to the bankruptcy court, was randomly allotted.
