
ORDER OF COURT REAPPOINTING UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE

In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. § 631 et seq., and the further authority granted an action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS ORDERED that STEPHEN C. RIEDLINGER be, and he is hereby reappointed as Full-Time United States Magistrate Judge for the Middle of District of Louisiana with his official station being designated as Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

The United States Magistrate Judge shall enter reappointment upon the performance of his duties on the 29th day of May, 2010, but prior to the commencement of such duties he shall take the oath or affirmance prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§ 453 and 631 (G).
