GENERAL ORDER
NUMBER 2005-12

Paragraph I.B of General Order Number 2005-09 is hereby amended as follows:

In order to ensure the random assignment of cases to the fullest extent possible in a fair and equitable manner, the Clerk of Court shall assign all cases filed on and after October 15, 2005 in the following manner until further orders of this Court.

B. Assignment of Cases

The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign civil cases in the following percentages:

Section JVP	20%
Section FJP	28%
Section RET	24%
Section JJB	28%

The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign criminal cases in the following percentages:


Section JVP	16%
Section FJP	28%
Section RET	28%
Section JJB	28%

All Orders or General Orders to the contrary are hereby vacated and set aside. This order shall be effective October 15, 2005.


