**ISSUANCE OF WRITS OF HABEAS CORPUS
IN CRIMINAL CASES**


The court finds that in the interest of Judicial Economy and efficiency, the following procedures shall be followed in issuing of Writs of Habeas Corpus in all Criminal Cases:

- (1) For those prisoners housed within the State of Louisiana, the Writ to produce said prisoner shall be in the possession of the United States Marshal at least **five (5) working days** prior to any hearing.
- (2) For those prisoners housed outside the State of Louisiana, the Writ to produce said prisoner shall be in the possession of the United States Marshal at least **ten (10) working days** prior to any hearing.
