
GENERAL ORDER #65

Handling Fee for Funds Deposited in the Court's
Interest-bearing Registry Account


The Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts has established a Registry Fee to be assessed for administration of funds held in the registry of the court and placed in interest-bearing accounts or instruments. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall deduct from income earned on registry funds invested in interest-bearing accounts or instruments; a fee not exceeding that authorized by the Judicial Conference of the United States and set by the Director of the Administrative Office. The fee shall be withdrawn whenever income earned becomes available for deduction and prior to any other distribution of funds in the case. The fee shall be deposited in the United States Treasury, without further order of the court. This assessment shall apply to all registry interest-bearing accounts in non-criminal proceedings.
