Paragraph I.B of General Order Number 01-2 is hereby amended as follows:

In order to ensure the random assignment of cases to the fullest extent possible in a fair and equitable manner, the Clerk of Court shall assign all cases filed on and after February 7, 2003 in the following manner until further orders of this Court.

I B Assignment of Cases

The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign civil cases in the following percentages:

Section A	15%
Section B	30%
Section C	30%
Section D	25%


The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign criminal cases in the following percentages:

Section A	16%
Section B	28%
Section C	28%
Section D	28%

All Orders or General Orders to the contrary are hereby vacated and set aside


