Paragraph I.B. of General Order Number 00-2 is hereby amended as follows:

In order to ensure the random assignment of cases to the fullest extent possible in a fair and equitable manner, the Clerk of Court shall assign all cases filed on and after January 19, 2001 in the following manner until further orders of this Court.

I. B. Assignment of Cases

The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign civil cases in the following percentages:

- Section A 15%
- Section B 25%
- Section C 30%
- Section D 30%

The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign criminal cases in the following percentages:

- Section A 16%
- Section B 28%
- Section C 28%
- Section D 28%

All Orders or General Orders to the contrary are hereby vacated and set aside.
