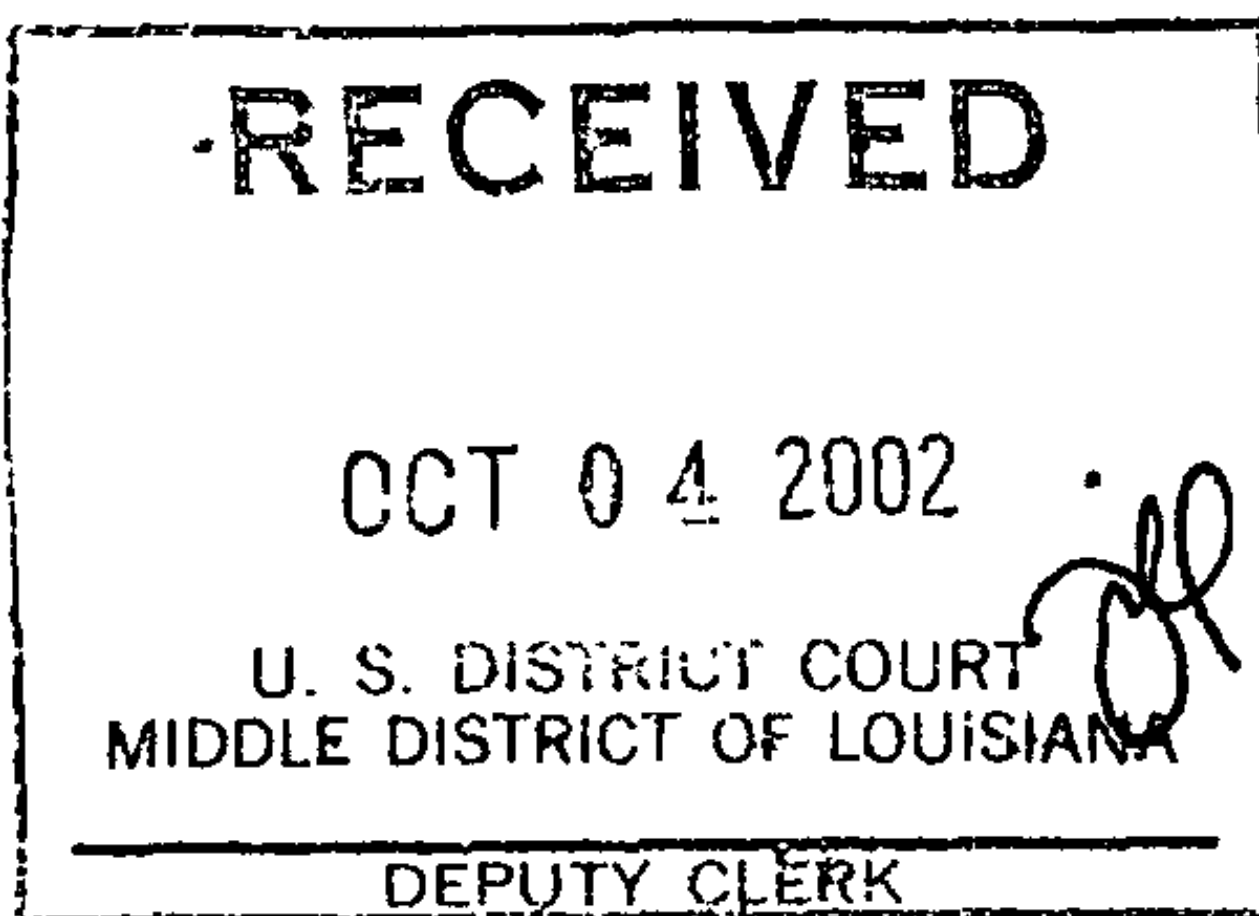

JUDGMENT

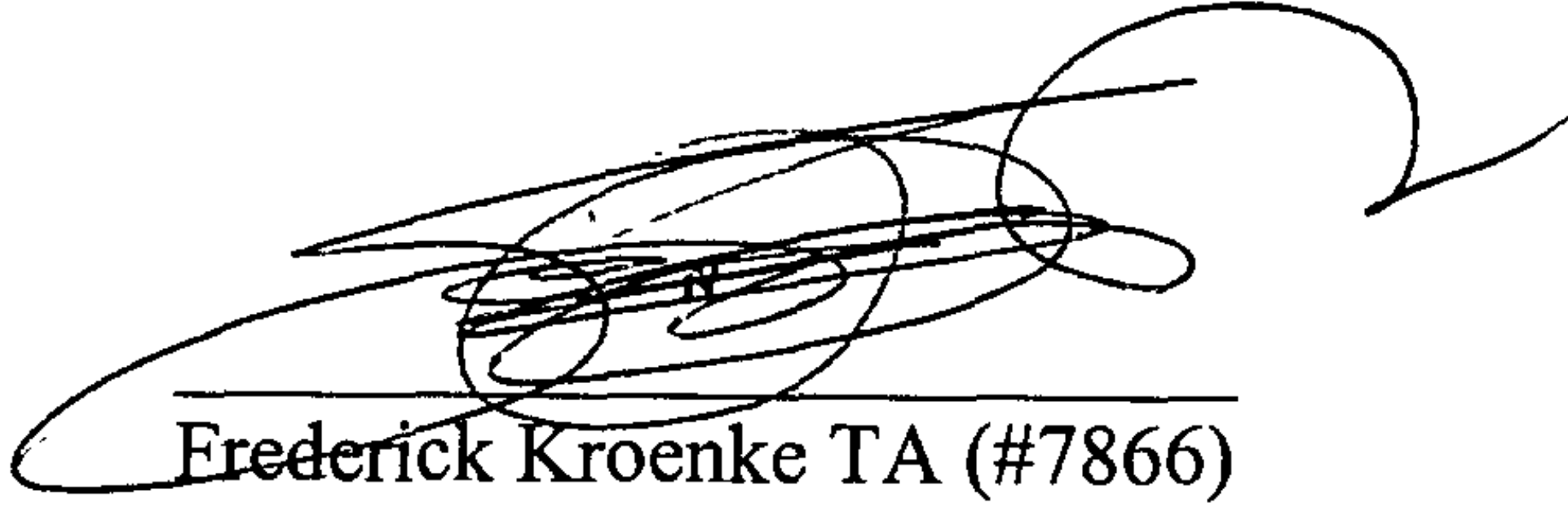
