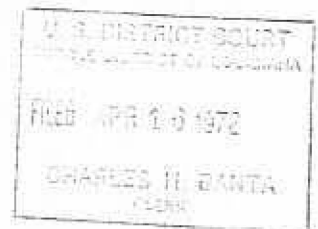

GENERAL ORDER
NUMBER 3

WHEREAS, the Act of December 18, 1971, created the
above entitled District;

Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority granted by
Title 28, United States Code, Section 751,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. All deputy clerks holding office in the Eastern District of Louisiana, Baton Rouge Division, immediately prior to the effective date of the said Act, are hereby appointed deputy clerks of the above entitled Court with the same powers and duties and at the same respective grades and salaries, with credit to be given in future promotions and step increases in salary for past services; and
2. The Clerk, C. HUBERT BANTA, named in General Order No. 2, and said deputies are continued in office as Clerk and deputy Clerks for the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana, Baton Rouge Division, as it existed prior to the effective date of the Act, for the purpose of performing such duties as may devolve upon them by statute for the Eastern District of Louisiana, as it existed prior to the effective date of said Act.

3. In the event individual reappointments are required for fiscal reasons, such individual appointments will be made as of the effective date of said Act.

This Order shall become effective commencing April 16, 1972.
