GENERAL ORDER NO. 36

IT IS ORDERED that in accordance with Rule 26 of the rules of this Court and 28 U.S.C. §636, all civil and criminal motions filed during the period beginning July 1, 1978, and ending August 31, 1978, shall be and each is hereby referred to Frank J. Polozola, United States Magistrate for the Middle District of Louisiana for further handling.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all dispositive motions as defined in 28 U.S.C. §636, the United States Magistrate shall prepare findings of fact, conclusions of law and a recommendation which shall be submitted to this Court for further action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all non-dispositive motions, the United States Magistrate shall be authorized to rule on such motions as provided in Rule 26 of the local rules of this Court and by 28 U.S.C. §636.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if a hearing is required on any motion referred to the United States Magistrate, the United States Magistrate shall be authorized to conduct whatever hearings that may be necessary to decide the pending motion.
