

Because of the increasing administrative burdens which are being placed upon the Chief Judge of this District,

IT IS ORDERED that there be a reduction in caseload equal to twenty percent of the pending cases. The Clerk of Court shall randomly select twenty percent of the pending cases in Section "A" and reassign them to Section "B", excluding cases which are presently assigned for trial. The Clerk of Court shall also rearrange the assignment cards so as to reduce future assignments to Section "A" by twenty percent.

This order shall be effective August 12, 1992.
