

Pleadings and other papers filed under seal in civil and criminal actions (excluding Grand Jury proceedings) shall be maintained under seal for thirty (30) days following final disposition of the action. After that time, all sealed pleadings and other papers shall be placed in the case record unless the District Judge or Magistrate Judge, upon motion, orders that the pleading or other paper be maintained under seal.
