In order to ensure the random assignment of cases to the fullest extent possible in a fair and equitable manner, the Clerk of Court shall assign all cases filed on and after September 1, 2005 in the following manner until further orders of this Court.

B. Assignment of Cases

The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign civil cases in the following percentages:

| Section JJB | 30% |


The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign criminal cases in the following percentages:

|             |     |
|-------------|-----|
| Section JVP | 16% |
| Section FJP | 28% |
| Section RET | 28% |
| Section JJB | 28% |

All Orders or General Orders to the contrary are hereby vacated and set aside. This order shall be effective September 1, 2005.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




