O R D E R

Due to the continuing affect of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita on a number of attorneys and their ability to access their files, General Order No. 2005-11 is amended as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that the PACER users with offices in the parishes of Beauregard, Calcasieu, Cameron, Jefferson Davis, Vermillion, Assumption, Jefferson, Lafourche, Orleans, Plaquemines, Saint Bernard, Saint Charles, Saint James, John the Baptist, Saint Tammany, Tangipahoa, Terrebonne and Washington are hereby determined to be exempt from the payment of PACER fees to access the court records of the United States District and Bankruptcy Courts for the Middle District of Louisiana for the period from Friday, August 26, 2005, through Friday, November 25, 2005.
