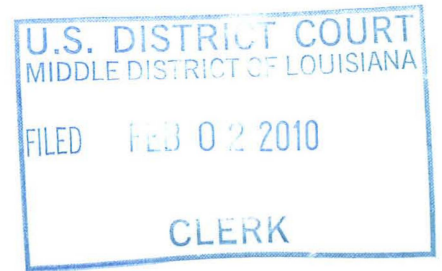


ORDER


