ORDER OF COURT APPOINTING UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE

In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. § 631, et seq., and the further authority granted, and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS ORDERED that Scott D. Johnson be, and he is hereby appointed as Full-Time United States Magistrate Judge for the Middle District of Louisiana with his official duty station being designated as Baton Rouge, Louisiana.
