ORDER

In accordance with the recommendation of the Remote Detention Working Group, a collaborative partnership of components of the judiciary and Department of Justice, and U.S. Marshal Service Director Ronald L. Davis;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a Detention Committee is established for the Middle District of Louisiana to identify and address detention-related challenges, including but not limited to access to counsel and discovery.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the membership of the Detention Committee shall be comprised of the following Middle District of Louisiana representatives:

- U.S. District Court Chief Judge or designee;
- U.S. Magistrate Judge;
- U.S. Marshal or designee;
- Representative, Criminal Justice Act Panel Counsel;
- Representative, Federal Public Defender's Office;
- Representative, U.S. Attorney's Office
- Representative, U.S. Probation and Pretrial Services Office

The Detention Committee shall meet from time to time until further Order.
